



# ONE GIRL CAN REALLY change the WORLD

TOPIC  
SCRIPTURE  
MATERIALS/ADVANCE PREP

Helping girls identify they were created with a purpose, have a passion to make a difference and have God's power to change the world.  
Luke 1:38

"One Girl Can Change the World" song by Shuree (available on iTunes)

## ENGAGE

Ask each girl to tell about a woman who has done something she thinks is great and why she thinks that. This could be a woman from history, her family, in the news etc.

## ENCOURAGE

Tell about a time you were given a task or responsibility to do something that would impact, affect or include others.

Tell how you felt about that, your feelings through it and what the outcome was. Example: Leading a school or community project, a role in a school play, watching your younger sibling for the first time, being a parent, playing a position on a team etc.

How somebody believed in you that they gave you that responsibility

How you were able to do it because of your trust in God's power to do it

How it made a difference in your life

## EXAMINE

Ask the girls if they have ever been entrusted with a task.

Have them share what it was with the group asking:

1. How did you feel when you were told you were going to do that? Nervous? Scared? Excited?
2. Did anyone give you help or guidelines to do it?
3. What was the outcome?

 **EQUIP****VERSE****"Luke 1:28-33"**

Read Luke 1:28 of The Message Version: "God sent the angel Gabriel to the Galilean village of Nazareth to a virgin engaged to be married to a man descended from David. His name was Joseph, and the virgin's name, Mary. Upon entering, Gabriel greeted her: Good morning! You're beautiful with God's beauty, Beautiful inside and out! God be with you." Share: The angel was sent by God and told her how God saw her and this is how He sees you...beautiful INSIDE and OUT. God is the creator of each one of you and He says that everything He makes is good.

Read Luke 1:29-33 "She was thoroughly shaken, wondering what was behind a greeting like that. But the angel assured her, "Mary, you have nothing to fear. God has a surprise for you: You will become pregnant and give birth to a son and call his name Jesus. Nothing, you see, is impossible with God. And Mary said, Yes, I see it all now: I am the Lord's maid {girl}, ready to serve. Let it be with me just as you say."

Mary was a young poor female. She was just living her life when the angel came to her with this call.

God created Mary with a PURPOSE. She would be the mother of our Savior. Mary had a PASSION, a strong love for God. And God gave Mary the POWER for that Purpose He had for her.

Don't be afraid to step out when God calls. But respond, "I'm your girl!!!" God, whatever you say, I'm down!!

 **EMPOWER**

Play the song 'One Girl Can Change the World' by Shuree.

Discuss how the song relates to them and what spoke to them in the song.

Share that in the song Shuree says: "I'm gonna! You're gonna! We're gonna change the world! Have the girls take hold of that by having them write Luke 1:38 NLT on an index card "I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true." And on the back of the card a note/prayer to God on their willingness to do what He calls them to do.

Ask the girls if they hear God calling them to do something and to share what that is if they do.

Remind them that they are not alone. God has placed you and other people in their life that will cheer them on.

**PRAYER**

Take prayer requests. Pray that the girls can identify and claim their Purpose, live with Passion to make a difference in this world and do everything in God's Power.
